Let us know if there are any errors. At this point, we can only fix editorial errors. No technical content can be changed.

When you submit the copyright form, the title and authors in the form must be **exactly identical** with the title and authors **in your camera-ready version** instead of your initial submission. This is especially critical for those papers which went through a revision.

There is no difference from the publication point of view as all the accepted papers will be uploaded to the IEEE digital library (Xplore) and Ei-indexed. However, for a better tracking, IEEE uses two separate links for authors to complete their copyright forms. The deadline is **December 3, 2022**.

Another important note is that you **do not need** to submit the final version of your paper to IEEE because the conference has already collected all the papers, examined their formats, and checked the similarity. In this way, we can speed up the proceedings preparation and reduce the time for papers to be published and indexed.
